This was a stand-alone comp to help competitors make it through the summer months before we get back to the full Rip & Grip Series in the fall.

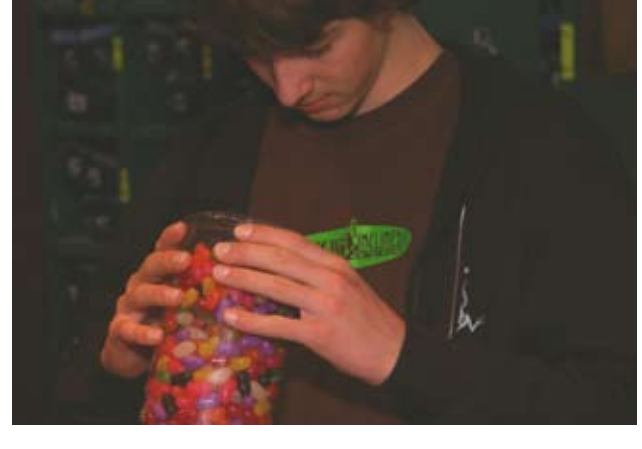
Another great event was put together by Nigel and the team at Vertically Inclined. Thirty new problems went up to challenge participants with everything from balancy technical moves to throws and dynos.

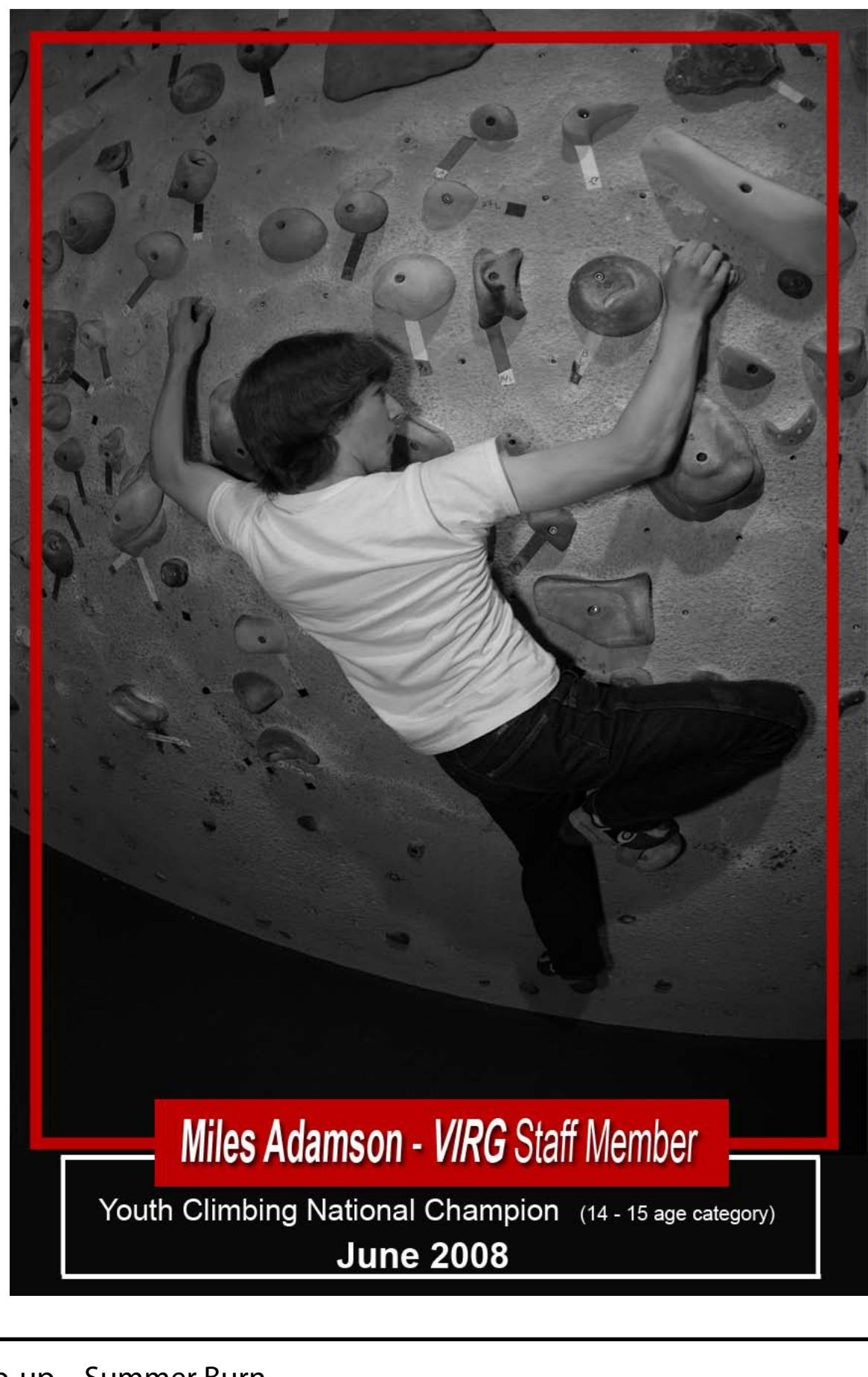

 -Labour Day Weekend - VIRG is CLOSED August 31st and September 1st

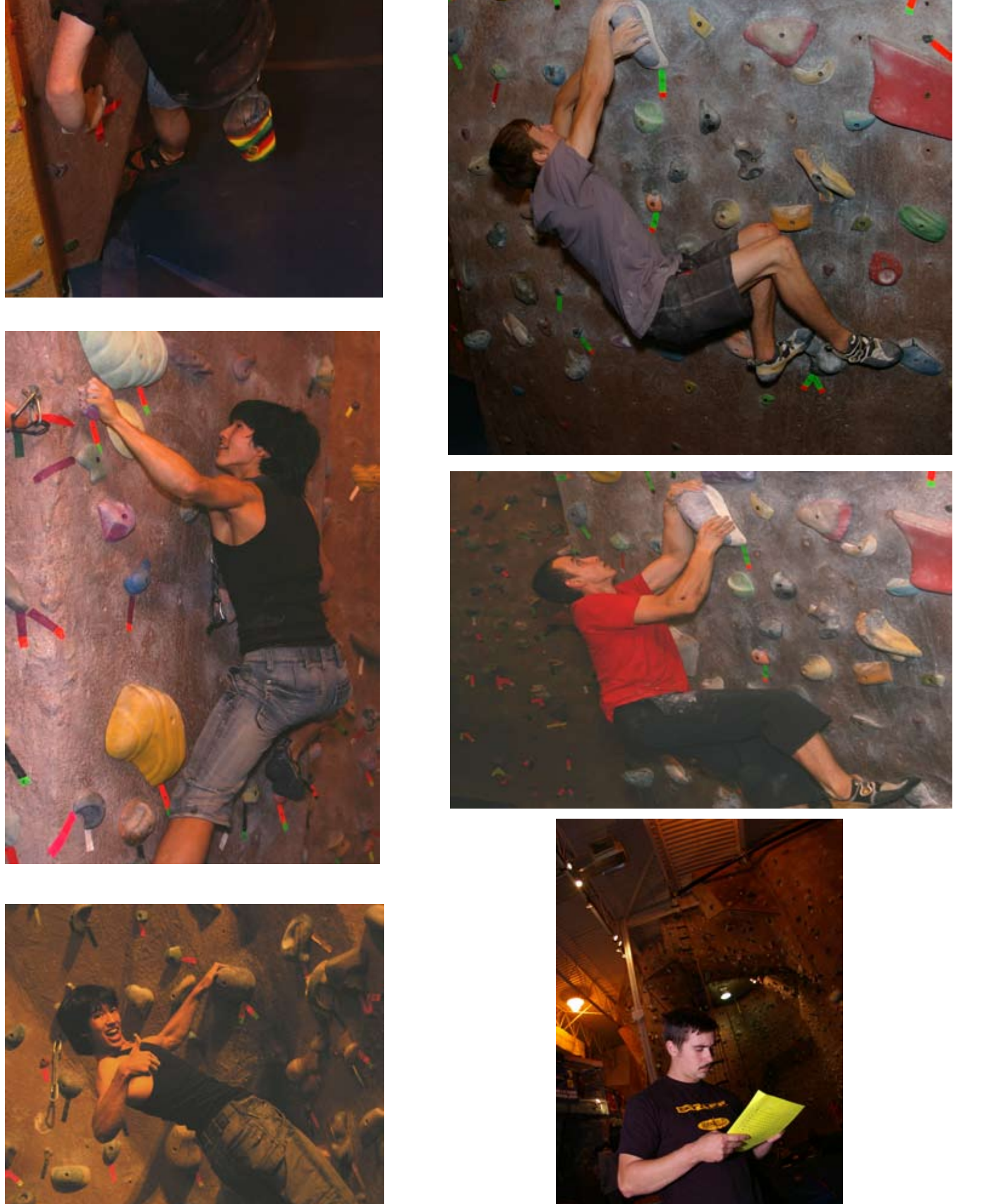
Rip & Grip
